2012 Instructor Application

Sail To Prevail is a nonprofit organization providing sailing opportunities for both the physically and developmentally disabled through our Adaptive Sailing program. We host over 1500 recreational and instructional sailors each summer from our docks at Fort Adams Park in Newport Harbor using an adaptive fleet of (5) Freedom20s, (1) Martin16 and (1) Sonar23.

The Disabled Sailing Program runs for 9 weeks / weekdays from June 13 to August 12 -- (2) two-hour sessions each day. We are looking for 5 certified sailing counselors and instructors to staff these sessions, and will pay each \$12.00 an hour with a guaranteed minimum salary of \$250 per week.

Our sailing instructor staff generally holds some level of certification from US Sailing – the recreational staff holding a Counselor’s certificate and the instructor staff holding the Level I Instructor certificate or higher. For interested applicants with prior sailing experience, we will sponsor and reimburse those we employ that need certification or wish to increase their level of certification at the start of the season.
